Minutes of the 4th meeting held on 02.07.2019 at 12:30 p.m. in the Committee Hall, Mini Secretariat Roopnagar under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar to review the action points of the draft action plan for control air pollution of Nangal town with the Stakeholder departments.

At the outset, the Asst. Environmental Engineer, PPCB informed that as Nangal town has been declared as non attainment town as the ambient air quality is not conforming to the prescribed standards in respect of PM₁₀ and in regard to which 3rd meeting had already been held on 29.05.2019 under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar. Now, the 4th meeting is being convened to review the progress/compliance of the decisions of the 3rd meeting and also the information regarding various activities as provided by different stakeholder departments.

Regarding shifting of industries from non-designated areas to industrial areas.

During 2nd meeting, as informed by Department of Town & Country planning, Master Plan for Nangal has not been notified yet. Even the draft Master plan has not been prepared for Nangal town, therefore it would be difficult to categorize the area designated for industrial activity. However, department of industries was asked to provide the information regarding the 12 no. of industries and also provide a list of industries that are registered with them outside the industrial Focal point of Nangal within the 5 Kms of limits of MC Nangal.

Detail regarding 12 industries in the Non-designated area of Nangal Town will be provided by within 3 days.

After listening to the submission chairperson decided that Punjab Pollution Control Board will identify the air polluting industries out of the 12 industries.

At the end, all the stake holder departments were agreed with the discussions of air pollution considered in the draft action plan and the timelines mentioned therein. Accordingly, it was decided to approve the action plan with above amendments / suggestions.
