Subject: - Minutes of the 6th meeting of District Environment Committee (DEC) held under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib on 10.11.2020 at 09:00 AM, through VC in compliance to Hon'ble NGT Order dated 26.09.2019.

At the outset of 6th Meeting of the District Environment Committee, District Sri Muktsar Sahib held on 10.11.2020 at 09:00 AM through VC under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib, the SDO, Punjab Pollution Control Board welcomed the Chairman and other members of the District Environment Committee. The list of Officials attended the meeting is enclosed as Annexure-1.

On the onset of meeting, SDO, PPCB informed that last meeting District Environment Committee was held on 06.10.2020. The progress on decisions of the last meeting dt. 06.10.2020 are to be discussed. The various issues discussed in the meeting are as under: -

- Review on compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Rules, 2016 with regards to Door to Door collection, Source Segregation, treatment of Wet Waste and treatment of Legacy Waste was discussed in detail with all the EO's of MC's. SDO, PPCB informed that due to non-compliance to MSW rules, 2016, the NGT Monitoring Committee during last VC dt. 04.09.2020 had imposed Bank Guarantees of Rs. 2 lac, 2 lac, 1.5 lac and 0.5 lac on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Malout, Gidderbaha and Bariwala respectively, for non-compliance door to door collection of MSW. Bank Guarantees of Rs. 1 lac and 1 lac on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib & Malout respectively for non-compliance source segregation. Bank Guarantees of Rs. 1 lac and 1 lac on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib and Malout respectively for non-compliance of treatment of Wet Waste. Bank Guarantees of Rs. 3 lac was imposed on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib for non-compliance treatment of legacy waste. MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib and NP Bariwala has deposited the bank guarantees but MC Malout and Gidderbaha yet to deposit the bank guarantees.
- Chairman of District Environment Committee, informed all the EO's that Hon'ble NGT Monitoring Committee is to check the compliance of MSW observations in the coming visit. So, it is requested to ensure compliance of all the observations in full satisfaction so as to avoid any adverse orders or encasement of bank guarantees.
- EO Sri Muktsar Sahib informed that it has made 100% door to door collection, source segregation and other observations shall be complied

soon. The work for Legacy Waste treatment is being executed but the progress is slow due to non-availability of required man power, which shall be improved in the days to come. During discussion on disposal of dead animals, SDM Sri Muktsar Sahib intimated the Chairman that pilot project at Moga has been executed and we may use it or plan for the similar at Sri Muktsar Sahib. EO MC Malout informed that work for construction of 1 no MRF shed has been started and thereafter the 4 no. secondary dump points shall be removed. Bank Guarantee as imposed by Hon'ble NGT Monitoring Committee are under preparation and shall be deposited with PPCB within a week. EO MC Gidderbaha also intimated that there is only 1 no. secondary point, 50% waste of which has been started collecting at MRF shed and this point shall be removed permanently. EO NP Bariwala informed that it has already made compliance to all the observations of NGT Monitoring Committee and bank guarantee has also been deposited with PPCB.

- CJM Sri Muktsar Sahib intimated the Chairman of the District Environment Committee that they have carried out IEC activities to prevent stubble burning in the near by villages. District Legal Service Authority shall carry out IEC activities in future as and when required by the MC's.
- The poor performance of both the existing STP's located at Sri Muktsar Sahib was discussed. SDO, Punjab Pollution Control Board, informed the Chairman that 2 no. STP's of capacity 5.7 MLD and 8.7 MLD being operated by DWSS are not being operated properly and all under maintenance since long. The STP of capacity 10 MLD at Malout and 7 MLD at Gidderbaha, both based on MBBR technology have now achieved the prescribed standards. The representative of Deptt. of Water Supply & Sanitation informed that desilting of STP's at Sri Muktsar Sahib is in progress to improve the quality of treated waste water. An additional STP of capacity 14 MLD alongwith new sewer line of 96 KM is proposed.
- SDO PPCB pointed out that untreated waste water of some part of Bariwala town is discharged into drain, which needs bio remediation as per orders of NGT Monitoring Committee. The presentation on bio remediation has already been done on 15.09.2017. SDO PWSSB informed that their department needs Rs. 5 lac deposited to execute the work and land of 1 acre on lease for atleast 2 year to be arranged by NP Bariwala. EO NP Bariwala informed that it shall be done shortly.
- Deputy Medical Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib informed that ETP for Civil Hospital, Sri Muktsar Sahib and Gidderbaha has been installed. Regarding ETP for CHC's located within the district, the matter was

taken up with the Health System Corporation and it was informed that ETP's for CHC's shall be considered in the second phase. The data of District Environment Plan relating to Bio-Medical Waste has been submitted to PPCB.

- The Department of Soil Conservation shall follow up the sanction/execution of irrigation schemes for all the STP's so as to not to discharge any treated/untreated effluent into any drain.
- SDO, Punjab Pollution Control Board, informed that 3 no recyclers and 1 no. dismantling facility for processing of E-Waste has been establishment in the state of Punjab as per the list enclosed, wherein complete address, contact no. and mail id has been given for information of all concerned departments especially Municipal Councils to enable them to dispose off the E-Waste which received by it alongwith the MSW. All the other departments may also deposit the E-Waste with any of the E-Waste recycling facility.
- SDO, Punjab Pollution Control Board, also intimated that the data on District Environment Plan collected from various departments have been compiled on prescribed proforma prepared by CPCB and submitted for approval of the District Environment Committee so that it may be sent to Directorate of Environment and Climate Change for preparing the state environment plan.

After detailed deliberation, the Chairman of the District Environment Committee decided as under:

1. All the EO's shall ensure 100% implementation on MSW Rules, 2016 and the observations relating to it, which have been pointed out and bank guarantees imposed by NGT Monitoring Committee.
2. All the MC's shall remove secondary dump points with scheme of each to be connected with MRF sheds because with the provision of MRF sheds, The concept of old scheme of secondary dump points be dispensed with immediately.
3. All the EO's shall explore the possibility to dispose off dead animals with facility provided at Moga.
4. SDM Sri Muktsar Sahib shall conduct meeting of president NP Bariwala, EO NP Bariwala and SDO, PWSSB to finalize the requirement of land on lease and funds of Rs. 5 lac so as to enable PWSSB to execute the bio-remediation project at Bariwala.

5. MC Malout & Gidderbaha shall submit the bank guarantees with PPCB immediately, as imposed by NGT Monitoring Committee during its review meeting dt. 04.09.2020.
6. District Legal Service Authorities shall continue the IEC Activities relating to various Waste Managements Rules.
7. Deptt. of Health shall ensure installation of ETP at Civil Hospital, Malout before 31.12.2020 and shall made operational the ETP's installed at Civil Hospital, Sri Muktsar Sahib and Gidderbaha.
8. Deptt. of Panchayati Raj shall plan treatment facility for remaining ponds within the district as per Hon'ble NGT order dt. 01.06.2020 on the subject.
9. The MC's shall dispose off the E-Waste received on its dump sites to any of the recycling facilities as per the list enclosed so as to make compliance of the E-Waste Management Rules, 2016.
10. The data on District Environment Plan prepared as per the prescribed proforma circulated by CPCB was approved and PPCB was directed to send it to Directorate of Environment and Climate Change, Chandigarh for their further necessary action to prepare the State Action Plan.

At the end the Chairman of the District Environmental Committee asked all the member departments to implement the decisions within the given time frame. All the member departments assured the Chairman for compliance of the decision of hearing in a time bond manner.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
