1. Ambient Air Quality Monitoring

The matter was taken up with the Head office laboratory and it was informed that the average of results upto March/2020 will be calculated before taking any decision in the matter.

Control on Burning of Bio-mass

In the 2nd meeting as informed by the Chief Agricultural officer, very few incident of burning of Biomass had occurred during the last paddy season and proper measures will be taken in the upcoming wheat season so that no such incident occurs.

PWD (B&R) informed in the previous meeting that pending work has been completed and potholes have been removed. The representative did not bring any written submission along with.

10. **Blacktopping of metalled road**

Identified 9 kms of following roads for black topping:
Kiratpur Sahib - Nangal Una road upto HP Border (NH 503 extr) with an estimate of 60 lacs upto 30.11.2019.
Chairperson decided that submission be taken on record and also directed Deptt. of PWD to bring the progress in writing in the next meeting and also expedite the work.

Due to rainy season, work has not yet started and will be completed within 1 month and the progress will be submitted in the next meeting.

Widening of road and infrastructure for decongestion of road

Identified following roads where alternate arrangement is required where roads can't be widened (Divider/ Flyover etc.)

1. Construction of H/L Bridge 5 span 22 mtr each crossing barari to Nangal up to Nangal Una road with an estimate of 4.25 crores and completion upto 27.9.2019.
2. Construction of 1 No. ROB at L-Crossing 88-C (1.375 KM) with an estimate of 123.80 crores from Central Govt. and completion upto 7.6.2020.

Chairperson directed that the PWD will bring the progress in writing in the next meeting and also directed that the meetings in future will be attended by either Executive Engineer himself or by some other officer who is well versed with the facts.

12. **Regarding shifting of industries from non-designated areas to industrial areas.**

After listening to the submission chairperson decided that Punjab Pollution Control Board will identify the air polluting industries out of the 19 industries.

Chairperson decided that the same list be sent to DTP Roopnagar/ Municipal Council to authenticate if any permission regarding land use has been granted for establishing the industry.

Environmental Engineer, Punjab Pollution Control Board informed that out of the list of 19 industries 5-7 units were visited and it was observed that the list does not contain industrial units as most of the units visited were commercial shops, showrooms or furniture shops. The matter was also taken up with DTP Roopnagar as to how one can consider an industrial unit in Non-designated area in the absence of Master Plan of Nangal. Department of industries informed that list is generated as an individual can register from home and according to them area outside Industrial area is a Non-designated area.
