#### Remarks

The case was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 98<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 07.07.2017, wherein the SCA-cum-SAC observed that:

- The case stands recommended by all the member departments except PCCF.
- PCCF vide letter No. 3240 dated 15.05.2017 has informed that DFO Nawanshahar vide letter No. 351-53 dated 24.04.2017 has sent the case to his office. The PCCF further informed that the proposal has been sent to the Govt. of India for according principle approval vide letter No. FCA/1980/PBIP/245/2016/605 dated 04.05.2017 after getting the compliance of the observations done from the user agency, which were earlier conveyed to SCA-cum-SAC from time to time.

PCCF vide letter No. 7791 dated 06.07.2017 informed that the Govt. of India has raised certain observations vide letter No. 9-PBB373/2017-CHA dated 05.06.2017 on the proposal sent by his office vide letter dated 04.05.2017. The observations as raised by the Govt. of India has to be replied/complied with by the user agency/DFO Nawanshahar and on receipt of the same, the reply to the Govt. of India will be sent on priority basis.

The SCA-cum-SAC perused letter No. 9-PBB373/2017-CHA dated 05.06.2017 vide which certain documents have been sought from the industry by the MoEF, Govt. of India and noted that the necessary permission to the industry will be considered by the MoEF, under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as and when the industry submits certain documents including copy of consent to establish (NOC) of the Board, which can only be granted by the Board after the grant of site clearance by the SCA-cum-SAC.

The SCA-cum-SAC further observed that Punjab Pollution Control Board has already recommended the case to SCA-cum-SAC for grant of environmental/site clearance to the industry.

After detailed deliberations & discussions, it was unanimously decided by the SCA-cum-SAC that:

(i) Punjab Pollution Control Board will issue the consent to establish (NOC) to the industry for its proposed project to enable the industry to submit the compliance report to MoEF, Govt. of India, MoEF&CC as sought by the Ministry vide letter 9-PBB373/2017-CHA dated 05.06.2017 for

obtaining permission under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the suitable conditions and with the special condition that the industry will obtain necessary permission from Govt. of India, MoEF&CC for diversion of 2.9350 ha (2.9199 ha area closed under PLPA + 0.01611 ha area PF) of forest land and to submit a copy of the same to Punjab Pollution Control Board.

- (ii) The industry be asked to obtain necessary permission from Govt. of India, MoEF&CC for diversion of 2.9350 ha (2.9199 ha area closed under PLPA + 0.01611 ha area PF) of forest land and to submit a copy of the same to SCA-cum-SAC, at the earliest possible.
- (iii) As and when the industry submits the copy of permission from Govt. of India, MoEF&CC for diversion of 2.9350 ha (2.9199 ha area closed under PLPA + 0.01611 ha area PF) of forest land to SCA-cum-SAC, the environmental clearance under Press Note 17 (1984 series) be granted to the industry as well as case be recommended to Director of Factories, Punjab for grant of site clearance as required under the Factories Act, 1948 after getting approval of the Chairman of the SCA-cum-SAC on the record file, subject to the conditions as proposed by the member departments. There is no need to bring the case before SCA-cum-SAC again and again.
