No.10/200/2020/STE(5)/223516: In exercise of powers conferred u/s 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 read with Notification No. S.O 289 (E) dated 14th April, 1988 of the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests, New Delhi and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 7 of the said Act and Rule 4 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to partially modify the order bearing no.10/48/2004-STE(4)/932 dated 15.10.2013 issued for setting up of new rice shellers and saila plants in the State of Punjab as under:-

- (1) Paragraph 9 I <u>Siting guidelines for the Rice Shellers and Saila Plants</u>
 In clause (1)A(ii),the words 'and 2 kms.' shall be substituted by the words 'and 1.5 kms.'
- (2) Paragraph 9 II Emission standards

Following note shall be inserted:

Note:

- For new rice shellers/saila plants coming within the distance of 1.5 kms to 2 kms from the local body limits, stringent emission standards of 350 mg/Nm³shall be applicable.
- For the units established or being established beyond 2 kms from the local body limits, the emission standards of 750mg/Nm³ as prescribed in the order dated 15.10.2013 shall remain applicable.
