Environmental Engineer, Punjab Pollution Control Board informed that progress on decision of meeting is not being received from the departments on timely basis as such Punjab Pollution Control Board is not able to compile the progress thus causing delay in conducting District Environment meeting on monthly basis. ADC(UD), SAS Nagar desired that all departments shall sent timely reports to Punjab Pollution Control Board on the decision of meeting of the District Environment Committee in future. Hon'ble NGT vide order dated 4 June 2021 in the matter has directed the Chief Secretary, Punjab and the Advisor to the Administrator, UT Chandigarh to take further appropriate remedial measures to comply with the mandate of law, including the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and this Tribunal. Further, a joint Committee of CPCB, PPCB and UTPCC was constituted to furnish a status report. - The immediate action is required to regulate the Dairies and Gaushalas located in villages of Chandigarh and Mohali by following the "Guidelines for Environmental management of Dairy Farms and Gaushalas" as per Orders of Hon'ble NGT on 20/05/2020, in the matter of OA No.46/2018.
- Respective Local Authorities/ULBs of Chandigarh Administration and Punjab Government are required to ensure that STPs shall be operated efficiently so as to achieve the prescribed parameters.
- Chandigarh Administration and Punjab Government must ensure that nosolid waste shall be dumped into the N-Choe or catchment area and no waste from Hadda Rodi sites is dumped into N-Choe/drain.

In compliance of the directions of Hon'ble NGT, a series of meetings were held under Worthy Chief Secretary, Punjab. During last meeting of worthy Chief Secretary, Punjab held on 26.11.2021,it was decided as under:

- MC, Chandigarh shall ensure that the work regarding tapping of untreated effluent leading to Jagatpura drain is completed by 31.12.2021.
- The work of tapping of untreated sewer/ storm water of sector 63, sewer near gate no. 4 of Cricket Stadium, sewer back side of Hockey Stadium and sewer from sector 80 into

- N-choe shall be completed by 31.01.2022.
- CA, GMADA shall ensure the up gradation of STP and shall ensure the utilization of treated effluent for construction purposes in a time boundmanner.
- A committee of the PSLG, PSHUD, PSSTE and Commissioner, MC, Chandigarh is constituted to deliberate upon the issues regarding stopping of discharge from villages from GMADA area, as well as dairies in village Faidan and Jagatpura which shall submit its report within 1 month.

Last meeting of the committee was held on 16.11.2022 wherein it was decided as under:

- The matter regarding stakeholder department (i.e GMADA or DRDP) whom the responsibility shall be levied for tapping of untreated effluent of villages, diaries, gaushalas, Meat Market being discharged into Jagatpura drain and N-choe shall be brought into the knowledge of worthy Chief Secretary for decision.
- 2. Another meeting of the committee constituted in compliance of worthy Chief Secretary, Punjab orders shall be held shortly and District Development & Panchayat Officer, Department of Rural Development & Panchayats, Mohali shall also be called during the meeting.
- 3. Punjab Pollution Control Board and MC, Mohali shall jointly visit to verify that work of tapping of untreated sewer/ storm water of sector 63, sewer near gate no. 4 of Cricket Stadium, sewer back side of Hockey Stadium and sewer from sector 80 into N-choe has been completed and submit report during next meeting.
- 4. The report of demarcation of village Faidan carried out by

Chamdigarh Administration shall be shared with SDM, Mohali for examining and comments whether the demarcation of village Faidan done is appropriate.

Thereafter, the matter regarding tapping/treatment of untreated effluent of rural areas falling under the GMADA jurisdiction i.e having diaries, gaushalas & Meat Market as well as villages discharging into Jagatpura drain and N-choe was considered at the level of Chief Secretary and it was decided that the responsibility for managing/treatment of such discharges shall be with GMADA authorities. GMADA written vide letter no. 25975 dated 09.12.2022 to take further action and submit action taken report on monthly basis to PPCB. Thereafter, GMADA has intimated that these areas falls under the jurisdiction of Department of Rural Development & Department of Water Supply & Sanitation and hence action is required to be taken by them.

Now, Advocate Sunaina has served legal notice vide letter dated 26.02.2023 and has given a time of 7 days to submit response on the action taken in compliance of the directions dated 05.01.2022 of Hon'ble NGT failing which she will file a Execution application in O.A no. 124 of 2021 before the Hon'ble NGT.
