- a. The soft copy of the Rules was circulated to all the Chief, Zonal and Regional Offices of the Board on 01.04.2016.
- b. Copy of the Rules was sent to Member Secretary, State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Punjab vide letter no. 2429 dated 03.05.2016 to incorporate the relevant conditions (constructional phase and operational phase) in the Environmental Clearances to be/being granted under EIA notification dated 14.09.2006. Accordingly, hereby following condition is imposed while granting Environmental Clearances to the construction projects:

Disposal of muck during construction phase should not create any adverse effect on the neighbouring communities and be disposed off after taking the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people with the approval of competent authority. The project proponent will comply with the provisions of Construction & Demolition Waste Rules, 2016. Dust, smoke & debris prevention measures such as wheel washing, screens, barricading and debris chute shall be installed at the site during construction including plastic / tarpaulin sheet covers for trucks bringing in sand & material at the site.

- c. Again all the Zonal offices and Regional Offices were requested vide this office letter no. 2522-42 dated 11.05.2016 to take necessary action for implementation of these Rules.
- d. The hard copy of the Rules was circulated to Director, Local Govt., Punjab vide letter no. 3193 dated 16.06.2016.
- e. Copies of the Rule were also circulated to Chief Administrator, PUDA; GMADA; GLADA; JDA; ADA; BDA and PDA vide letter no. 3198-3204 dated 17.06.2016 for taking further necessary action at their level also.
