The case of the industry was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 101<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 12.04.2018, wherein, it was observed that:-

- ➤ PCCF vide letter No. 338 dated 11.04.2018 informed that the industry has established its unit on NH-7 Bathinda-Zirakpur (Km 175-176) where the industry has its gate (approach to the industry through 'katcha rasta'), which is from NH-7 and the industry has its main gate on km 176-177 where the industry has its approach to the industrial plant and forest area is affected with the establishment of industrial project. Therefore, the industry is required to obtain prior permission from Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The PCCF further informed that the industry should apply online for obtaining the said permission.
- ➤ The Punjab Pollution Control Board vide letter No. 1224 dated 05.04.2018 has recommended that site clearance for the expansion project of the industry may not be considered due to the following reasons:
  - a) The industry has not obtained renewal of consent to operate of the Board under Water Act, 1974 & Air Act, 1981 and is not complying with the conditions of consents to operate granted under Water Act, 1974 & Air Act, 1981 for the existing capacities.
  - b) The industry has commissioned its expanded unit without the prior permission of the Board as well

as site clearance from CSA-cum-SAC.

- c) The industry has not submitted proper feasibility report for treatment of trade effluent to be generated from the lab section i.e. 1.6 KLD as solar evaporation pond does not seems to be adequate for this trade effluent of 1.6 KLD.
- ➤ Comments from DOI are awaited. Addl. Director of Industries & Commerce informed that their department has also 'No objection' for grant of site clearance to the industry and the written comments will be sent within 2-3 days.
- ➤ Comments from DOA are awaited. Representative of DOA informed that their Department has 'No Objection' for grant of environmental clearance to the industry and the written comments will be sent within 2-3 days, positively.

After detailed discussions, it was unanimously decided by SCA-cum-SAC as under:-

- (i) Observations raised by PPCB & PCCF be conveyed to the industry for immediate compliance and submission of compliance report to the concerned departments under intimation to SCA-cum-SAC.
- (ii) PPCB & PCCF be asked to send the fresh recommendations immediately on receipt of compliance of above noted observations from the industry.
- (iii) DOI & DOA be asked to send the written comments/recommendations, immediately.
- (iv) Case be dropped from the agenda till the industry complies with the observations raised by PPCB & PCCF.

The above-mentioned decisions of SCA-cum-SAC has been conveyed to the industry. The industry has submitted the reply to the same. The case will be considered in the next meeting of SCA-cum-SAC.

2. M/s Samcast Techniks, Sirhind Tohra Road, Near Canal Bridge, Village Chanalon, Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib The case of the industry was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 101<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 12.04.2018, wherein, it was observed that:-

- ➤ The Punjab Pollution Control Board vide letter No. 1134 dated 05.04.2018 has recommended to decline the site clearance to the industry due to the following reasons:-
- (i) As per feasibility report the new induction furnace is having capacity of 7 TPH. As details submitted in the application form, is has proposed 6 TPH new induction furnace replacing 1.5 TPH existing furnace. But in feasibility report attached, it submitted new induction furnace of capacity 7 TPH.

- (ii) The industry in its application has mentioned the total requirement of water as 20 KLD. However, in the water requirement chart the water requirement is only 8 KLD.
- (iii) The industry has mentioned the final discharge into inland surface water, which is not permissible.
- (iv) The total capital investment proposed on pollution control as percentage of total investment of the industry is not 3% as mentioned and is very lesser than this amount.
- ➤ DOF, Punjab vide letter No. 3377 dated 09.04.2018 has informed that the 'On site emergency plan' submitted by the industry with the application is not with concerned industrial unit, which is required to be modified & prepared accordingly. DOF further informed that the industry has not submitted the compliance report of the earlier site clearance letter issued vide No. 3245 dated 09.04.2008 and the industry has not submitted any record at the time of visit by the representative of Factories Department.

DOF has recommended that the site clearance may be granted to the industry only after compliance of above-noted observations.

- Comments from DOI are awaited. Addl. Director of Industries & Commerce informed that their department has also 'No objection' for grant of site clearance to the industry and the written comments will be sent within 2-3 days.
