Minutes of 1st meeting of District Level Special Task Force (DLSTF) held on 29.11.2019 at 11:00 pm in Mini Secretariat, Sangrur under the Chairmanship of the Additional Deputy Commissioner(G), Sangrur on behalf of Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur to discuss/monitor the progress of activities of Action Plan for Solid Waste Management.

The list of the participants is attached herewith as Annexure-A.

At the outset, the Environmental Engineer, Regional Office, Sangrur welcomed all the officers and representatives of the Local Bodies. He apprised them about the Action Plan prepared for handling & management of solid waste to ensure compliance of provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, as per the directions passed by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. He also apprised them about the obligations of the various stakeholder departments under the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016. He further informed that in order to monitor the progress of the Action Plan, following four level committees were formed:

- Central Monitoring Committee headed by MoEF.
- Regional Level Monitoring Committee headed by Hon'ble Justice Pritam Pal, former Judge, Punjab & Haryana High Court.
- State Level Monitoring Committee headed by the Worthy Chief Secretary.
- District Level Monitoring Committee headed by the Deputy Commissioner.

The District Level Special Task Force (DLSTF) has been formed under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner to discuss/monitor the progress of the activities to be performed under the action plan. The progress of action plan is to be monitored through eight proformas received from the Principal Secretary, Department of Science, Technology and Environment. Additional Deputy Commissioner (G), Sangrur explained that Door to Door collection should be 100% by 31.12.2019 by all the 13 MCs /NPs of Distt. Sangrur, to ensure source segregation, conversion of wet waste into compost and channelization of other components of the Solid Waste as per the revised timelines mentioned in the directions passed by the Hon'ble NGT in OA No 199/2014. Thereafter, the progress of all the MCs/NPs regarding the management of solid waste with regard to eight proformas was discussed as under:-

Municipal Council, Sangrur:

Sh. Rohit C.F., M.C., Sangrur explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 48%. He further informed that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 24 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 08 no. mechanized vehicles and 52 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Sunam:

Sh. Sanjay Kumar, EO, Municipal Council, Sunam explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 100%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 54 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 04 no. mechanized vehicles and 30 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Malerkotla:

Sh. Chander Prakash, EO, Municipal Counc®, Malerkotla explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 62%. He further stated that 02 no. material recovery facilities have also been commissioned & 63 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned.. There are 19 no. mechanized vehicles and 55 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Ahmedgarh:

Sh. Chander Prakash, EO, Municipal Council, Ahmedgarh explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 60%. He further, informed that 15 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 9 no. mechanized vehicles and 46 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Dirba:

Sh. Chander Prakash, EO, Municipal Council, Dirba explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 75%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 26 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 2 no. mechanized vehicles and 52 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Nagar Panchayat, Moonak:

Smt. Baljinder Kaur, EO, Nagar Panchayat, Moonak explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 100%. She further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 18 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 3 no. mechanized vehicles and 13 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Lehragaga:

Sh. Surinder Kumar, Accountant, Municipal Council, Lehragaga explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 80%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 34 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 4 no. mechanized vehicles and 36 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Bhawanigarh:

Sh. Rakesh Kumar, EO, Municipal Council, Bhawanigarh explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 100%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 21 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 5 no. mechanized vehicles and 19 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Nagar Panchayat, Amargarh:

Sh. Rakesh Kumar, EO, Nagar Panchayat, Amargarh explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 100%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 26 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 1 no. mechanized vehicle and 20 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Nagar Panchayat, Khanauri:

Sh. Mukesh Singla, EO, Nagar Panchayat, Khanauri explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 45%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 21 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 4 no. mechanized vehicles and 15 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Longowal:

Sh. Maninder Pal Singh, EO, Municipal Council, Longowal explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 70%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 25 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 1 no. mechanized vehicle and 13 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Nagar Panchayat, Cheema:

Sh. Maninderpal Singh, EO, Nagar Panchayat, Cheema explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 80%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 12 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned. There are 1 no. mechanized vehicle and 5 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

Municipal Council, Dhuri:

Sh. Rajesh Kumar, Sanitary Inspector, Municipal Council, Dhuri explained that Door to Door collection of MSW is 100% and source segregation is approximately 60%. He further stated that 01 no. material recovery facility has also been commissioned & 03 no. compostable pits have been constructed and commissioned.. There are 9 no. mechanized vehicles and 44 no. manual compartmentalized & covered manual tricycles.

After deliberations, it was decided as under:-

- 1) All the MCs/ NPs shall adhere to the timelines mentioned in the action plan for implementation of various activities for management of Solid Waste as mentioned in the order passed by the Hon'ble NGT on 22.12.2016 in O.A. No. 199/2014.
- 2) All the EOs of MCs / NPs shall submit the progress report in eight proformas sent by Principal Secretary, Department of Science, Technology & Environment, in the $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ week of every month to monitor the progress of the Action Plan prepared by the Directorate of Environment & Climate Change.
- 3) All the EOs of MCs / NPs shall intimate the status of identification of site for handling of C&D waste.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
