Subject: Minutes of the 9th meeting of District Environment Committee (DEC) held under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib on 14.07.2021 at 09:00 AM, through VC in compliance to Hon'ble NGT Order dated 26.09.2019.

At the outset of 9th Meeting of the District Environment Committee, District Sri Muktsar Sahib held on 14.07.2021 at 09:00 AM through VC under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib; the Punjab Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Bathinda welcomed the Chairman and other members of the District Environment Committee. The list of Officials attended the meeting is enclosed as Annexure-1.

On the onset of meeting, Junior Environmental Engineer, PPCB, Regional Office Bathinda informed that last meeting District Environment Committee was held on 19.01.2021. The progress on decisions of the last meeting dt. 19.01.2021 are to be discussed. The various issues discussed in the meeting are as under: -

Review on compliance of Municipal Solid Waste Rules, 2016

- PPCB informed that due to non-compliance to MSW Rules, 2016, the NGT Monitoring Committee during last VC dt. 04.09.2020 had imposed Bank Guarantees of Rs. 2 lac, 2 lac, 1.5 lac and 0.5 lac on MC,Sri Muktsar Sahib, Malout, Gidderbaha and Bariwala respectively, for non-compliance door to door collection of MSW. Bank Guarantees of Rs.1 lac and 1 lac on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib & Malout respectively for non-compliance source segregation. Bank Guarantees of Rs. 1 lac and 1 lac on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib and Malout respectively for non-compliance of treatment of Wet Waste. Bank Guarantees of Rs.3 lac was imposed on MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib for non-compliance treatment of legacy waste. All the MC's have now deposited the bank guarantees as imposed by Hon'ble NGT Monitoring Committee.
- EO, Sri Muktsar Sahib informed that it has made 98% door to door collection, 93% source segregation. There are 4 no. secondary point at sabji mandi, Burha Gujjar Road, Jalalabad Road and at Abohar Road, which have been removed. The work for Legacy Waste treatment is being executed but the progress is slow due to non- availability of required man power, which shall be improved in the days to come till date 400 ton of waste has been treated. Regarding removal of dead animals, it was intimated that incinerator at Moga for the purpose is not yet put in operation, so the MC shall explore the possibility to install the incinerator within the district itself. However, the dead animals are now a days are sent to the nearest hadda rori.
- EO, Malout informed that it has made 100% door to door collection, 100% source segregation. There are 4 no. secondary point at Power House,

Punjab Palace, Ravidaş area and Birla Road. Out of these 3 secondary dump points at Power House, Punjab Palace, Ravidas area have been removed. The secondary dump point located at Birla road will removed in next month. Out of 3 no. MRF's, 2 no. MRF sheds are under construction.

- EO, MC Gidderbaha informed that it has made 100% door to door collection and source segregation. There was only 1 no. secondary point, which had already been removed.
- EO, NP Bariwala informed that it has already made compliance to all the observations of NGT Monitoring Committee as door to door collection and segregation is 100%.

Status and Performance of STP's

- Punjab Pollution Control Board, informed the Chairman that 2 no. STP's of capacity 5.7 MLD and 8.7 MLD being operated by DWSS are not being operated properly and all undermaintenance since long. The STP of capacity 10 MLD at Malout and 7MLD at Gidderbaha, both based on MBBR technology have now achieved the prescribed standards. The samples of STP 3 MLD at Malout based on WSP technology failed in month March-2021 and April-2021. The Xen, Deptt. of Water Supply & Sanitation informed that as per recommendations of NGT Monitoring Committee, the STP's are to be transferred to Sewerage Board. The SDO, PWSSB ensured that in future STP will be operated properly so that prescribed standards will be achieved.
- Xen Panchayati Raj, Sri Muktsar Sahib informed that the department utilized fund under MANREGA and work for treatment of 3 no. villages namely Bhundar, Rupana and ChakTamkot. The work for treatment of pond of village Bunder and Rupana have been completed. The work for treatment of pond of village Chak Tamkot is under progress, which shall be completed within this month. The funds for remaining 14no.villages have been requested.

After detailed deliberation, the Chairman of the District Environment Committee decided as under:

- All the EO's shall ensure 100% implementation on MSW Rules,2016 and the discrepancies relating to it.
- 2. MC, Sri Muktsar Sahib shall remove secondary dump points located at Burha Gujjar, Jalalabad road and Abohar Road.
- 3. PPCB shall verify and check whether all the GVP's have been removed.
- 4. ADC (Urban Development), EO, Sri Muktsar Sahib and PPCB shall explore the viability of establishing the incinerator / rendering plant at Sri Muktsar Sahib for disposal and treatment off dead animals.
- EO, Malout shall remove remaining 1 no. secondary dump point / GVP located at Birla Road by 31.08.2021.

- **6.** EO, Malout shall construct and operate the remaining MRF Sheds immediately.
- 7. Deptt. of Panchayati Raj shall get the work completed of the ongoing village pond namely Chak Tamkot by 30.07.2021 and shall provide treatment facility for remaining village ponds within the district before timeline i.e 30.06.2022.
- PPCB shall get analyzed the samples of the treated waste water of village Bhunder and Rupana.
- Xen DWSS, Sri Muktsar Sahib & SDO PWSSB shall operate all the STP's efficiently so as to achieve the prescribed standards.

At the end the Chairman of the District Environmental Committee asked all the member departments to implement the decisions within the given time frame. All the member departments assured the Chairman for compliance of the decision of hearing in a time bound manner.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
