Sir,

This has reference to CPCB letter no - F.No.B-31011/BMW(50)/2017/WMD-I/1629 dated 20.10.2017 on the subject as cited above.

The clarification to the queries that whether EC is required in the following cases; may please be seen as below :

1. CBMWTF desires to replaces the existing incinerator and install new incinerator of same capacity

Clarification : EC will be required, as there might be configuration changes that might impact the performance efficiency of the incinerator.

2. After installing new incinerator, the old incinerator is kept as standby and operated only in case there is any breakdown

Clarification : Since capacity is increasing on installation of new incinerator, hence, EC is required.

3. CBMWTF increases its capacity only for disinfection by autoclaving/microwaving (but not incinerator);

Clarification : EC in this case can be applied under Clause 7 (ii) of EIA Notification, 2006.


