ORDER

The Punjab Pollution Control Board had issued a notice under section 31-A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 on 26th July, 2017, to all the stake-holders / general public in the form of public notice published in the leading newspapers inviting objections / suggestions within one month for putting a complete ban on the manufacture, sale, purchase, fitting and use of multitone horns / pressure horns and cracker-sound emitting silencers / devices fitted with motorcycles/ motor vehicles in the State of Punjab.

Now, after taking into consideration the matter and the fact that the multitone horns / sirens, sound producing devices fitted with the motor vehicles cause inconvenience to the general public and these multitone horns / sirens, mechanical devices have deleterious effect on human health and the psychological well-being of the people, I, Kahan Singh Pannu, IAS, Chairman, Punjab Pollution Control Board in exercise of the powers conferred under section 31-A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 hereby issue the following directions:-

"No person / agency shall manufacture sell, purchase, fit or use multitone horns / pressure horns and cracker-sound emitting silencers / devices with motorcycles / motor vehicles in the State of Punjab."

The above directions will come into force with effect from 1st October, 2017 and the failure to comply with the above direction shall be punishable under section 37 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 which entails imprisonment, after conviction, for a period upto 6 years and fine upto Rs.5,000/- every day.

OFFICE ORDER

The Government of Punjab vide notification no. 3/11/2013-STE(4)/145 dated 26.02.2014 has notified the comprehensive guidelines for the regulation of noise / sound pollution and the maintenance of ambient air quality standards.

Multitone horns/pressure horns and cracker-sound emitting silencers / devices fitted with motorcycles / motor vehicles cause impulsive increase in the ambient air noise levels beyond the permissible standards, which causes inconvenience to the general public leading to deleterious effect on health of living beings and the psychological well-being of the people, besides becoming a cause of major accidents.

The Board in exercise of the powers conferred u/s 31-A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 vide order no. 621 dated 6/9/2017 has issued the following directions:

"No person / agency shall manufacture sell, purchase, fit or use multitone horns / pressure horns and cracker-sound emitting silencers / devices with motorcycles / motor vehicles in the State of Punjab."

These directions have come into force with effect from 1st October, 2017.

For effective implementation of the above directions i.e. ban on the use of multitone horns / pressure horns and cracker-sound emitting silencers / devices with motorcycles / motor vehicles in the State of Punjab, Board in its 177th meeting held on 16/10/2017 has delegated powers to its Environmental Engineers (Incharge Regional Offices) and higher officers for affording opportunity of personal hearing and / or taking other appropriate action against the person / agency found violating the above directions.
